The Blues Anoraks Bio - The Blues Anoraks, Gloucester Blues Duo, were formed in 2002. The sound of the Blues Anoraks is based on the live interaction between the full on, blues harp and vocal sound of Mr Bill Pullin, and the syncopated, 'chugging guitar riffs' and supporting vocals of (Dr) Dave Camp including the Dr's lead vocals on a number of high energy boogies. There are always plenty of harp solos and the sound is totally live.



Since 2002 The Blues Anoraks have played many gigs around the Gloucestershire, Worcestershire, Evesham pub circuits, having often performed at the Upton and Gloucester Blues Festivals. As the name suggests, The Blues Anoraks love to perform many of the excellent, but more obscure Blues classics such as, 'Lemon Squeezing Daddy' and 'Sell My Monkey' which have incidentally become two of the main crowd pleasers, together with some better known classics such as 'Stormy Monday' and the 'Crawling Kingsnake'.

The Blues Anoraks are committed to the performance of live music and have built up a vast repertoire of songs which would enable them to play all night long (for the right fee).
